

PREMIUM MAGNETIC KNIFE RACK

FIXING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Remove the bracket from the reverse of the knife rack by pulling on the plastic pull tabs to separate the bracket from the rack, ensuring it is completely clear of the magnet. Take extra care that the bracket does not snap back onto the magnet as this could cause injury. Dispose of the plastic strip responsibly, as it is no longer required

2. Place the bracket in your desired location and use a spirit level to ensure the bracket is level. Make a pencil mark in the centre of each of the 2 holes.

Wall plugs and screws are provided for general use. Please ensure they are suitable to your favoured location and where appropriate replace with fittings specifically designed for your particular wall type

3. If using the wall plugs and screws provided, drill 2 holes to a depth of 30mm into the wall using an appropriate diameter bit for your chosen fixing type. Carefully tap your wall plugs into each hole.

4. Loosely screw the bracket in position, ensuring the countersunk (recessed) screw holes are facing you. Use a spirit level to ensure the bracket is straight before tightening the screws.

The rack can now be attached to the bracket. Due to the strength of the magnet it is most important to keep your fingers from being trapped between the bracket and the rack.

5. Holding the rack in both hands, with fingers clear of the back edge, position one side of the rack on the edge of the bracket before carefully lowering the opposite side onto the bracket. It will snap into place.

If you have any doubts in fixing the rack, please contact a qualified tradesman.

Please ensure this magnetic rack is mounted securely and well beyond the reach of children

Warning: Contains strong magnet

This rack should be kept at least 20cm away from credit cards, computer hard drives, watches, TVs, data storage media and other electronic devices and objects. Failure to do so may cause permanent damage.

People with pacemakers must avoid handling magnets, including this rack.
